## Day 4: Punakha Wonders and a Drive to Paro





100% of the Total Trip Cost is Payable to Confirm Your Booking. If cancellations are made 30 days before the start date of the trip, 50% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.

If cancellations are made 15-30 days before the start date of the trip, 75% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.

If cancellations are made within O-15 days before the start date of the trip, 100% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.

In the case of unforeseen weather conditions or government restrictions, certain activities may be canceled and in such cases, the operator will try his best to provide an alternate feasible activity. However, no refund will be provided for the same.

## FAQs:

#### What are the documents required for a Bhutan visa for Indians?

- Indian nationals can enter BHU through the land borders or take a flight without a visa, but they must obtain an entry permit. The list of documents required for a BHU visa is pretty straightforward.
- To get an entry permit for Bhutan, Indian citizens need to provide the following documents.
- Original passport with a minimum of six months of validity or original Indian Voter ID card
- · Two passport-sized photographs
- Travel insurance for the entire duration of the trip(It can be obtained in Phuentsholling at INR 500/person, you can get same insurance in Indian for INR 300/person).
- Children under the age of 18 can either show their passport with a minimum of 6 months validity or their birth certificate if it is in the English language. Children under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by an adult or legal guardian.

#### What are the requirements for a Bhutan visa for Indians?

• To visit Bhutan (BHU), Indian citizens are required to carry any one of the valid travel documents. It could be either an original valid Indian passport with a minimum of 6 months of validity or an original Indian Voters Identity Card.

#### What currency works in Bhutan and how can we exchange it?

• Bhutan's official currency is the Ngultrum (BTN), but Indian Rupee is also widely accepted here. It's advisable to carry sufficient local currency, especially when venturing into remote areas where card payments may not be accepted. You can exchange the currency on Day 1/2 in Phuentsholling.

#### How much is the Sustainable Development Fee for Indian tourists visiting Bhutan?

• For Indian tourists, the Sustainable Development Fee (SDF) to enter BHU is INR 1,200/- per person per night. While children aged between 6-12 years have to pay 50% of SDF, it is waived off for children aged 5 years and below. This fees is included in your package cost.

#### How can we get a Sim in Bhutan?

 Staying connected during your Bhutanese trip can become more hassle-free if you opt to get a local SIM card. Bhutan Telecom and TashiCell are the two primary telecom operators in the country. Both providers offer SIM cards to tourists, allowing access to local networks for calls, texts, and data services. To obtain a local SIM card, you will have to provide a copy of your passport and a passport-sized photograph for the SIM card registration process. You can also opt fot International Roaming.

#### Where we can get a Sim in Bhutan?

You can get a sim in in Phuentsholling on Day 1/2.

#### What is the process for booking and securing a spot on the trip?

You pay a booking amount of INR 25,000 to book your spot. The remainder amount is payable 20 days before departure.



#### How is communication managed during the trip?

• A Whatsapp group shall be created 5 days before the departure date which shall be used for coordination and updates throughout the trip.

## At what time and where are we supposed to assemble in Siliguri to leave for Phuentsholling on Day 1?

• Everyone is expected to be at Siliguri airport by 11AM on 28th April so we can begin on time.

#### What meals will be provided during the trip?

• 6 Breakfasts and 6 Dinners (Starting from Day 1 Dinner, till Day 7 Breakfast). It will have both the options Veg and Non Veg.

#### Is there a group leader accompanying the journey?

• Yes! Experienced people who have been to the location multiple times shall be accompanying you.

#### What is the policy for refunds or cancellations?

• The cancellation policy is mentioned in your itinerary. Please refer to the same.

#### What's the group size of this trip?

The group size will be between 25-35 people.

#### What sort of transportation is provided between destinations?

• You will be traveling in a comfortable SUV throughout the trip.

#### Are Airport transfers included?

Yes

#### Can solo travelers join this trip?

Yes! You can join our group that consists of a lot of other solo travelers too!

#### When should I book my return flight/mode of transport for?

• We will reach Siliguri on 3rd May by late evening. Your stay is booked for that night. You can book your return anytime on the 4th.

#### What kind of weather conditions can be expected during the trip?

Between 7 to 20 Dregree Celcius

#### Are entry charges to Monuments and Museums Inlcuded?

• No its not included, entry charges will be born by the customer on the spot.
